







Heavy breed, very early and prolific, thrives in stalls as well as on grassland

BREED STANDARD

SUFFOLK

Head

- Expressive
- Hornless
- Woolless
- Covered with a fine, shiny black coat
- Some white or brown hair tolerated, as well as a tuft of wool on the forehead in young dogs
- Ears long, thin and slightly lower slightly lower than horizontal.
- Thin border of brown wool is tolerated around the neck

Neckline

- Medium neck
- Without folds or dewlap
- Well fused in the shoulders in the male

- White in colour, fine 2/3
- The closed fleece covers the whole body from the legs to the knees and hocks, the neck to the nape of the neck.

Weights

Rams: 80 to 150 kg Ewes: 65 to 90 kg

Chest

- Long
- Cylindrical
- Rounded ribs
- Chest and withers wide
- Topside close to the horizontal
- Tail set on in line with the back

Members

- Well poised
- Fore and hind legs well apart to allow maximum development of muscles.
- Legs developed, as low as possible.
- Legs covered below the knee and hock with a fine, glossy black coat, some brown or white hair tolerated.

Clear, fine, without spots.

Eliminating defects

- Presence of horns
- Light or spotted facies and ears
- Begus or prognathic animals
- Skin too wrinkled
- Poor legs
- Black hocks in the fleece or spots
